### TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Software licensed under the academic program will be limited to academic instruction/research usage. Usage for commercial or government purposes requires a commercial license.

Technical Support: All academic customers, regardless of license package or offer, are entitled to full e-support (web-based) services, including access to hotline by email and access to forums. Telephone support is not included.

Single use licenses are fixed to a single machine/server - customers must purchase licenses for each machine that will run the software. ILOG software may be used to design, develop, test and run applications on that machine only. Licenses are fixed to a single operating system.

Floating licenses are installed on a server and any client machine can access the license. Floating licenses are cross-platform.

Two-user floating licenses are available for double the single-use price.  
All Academic Research Licenses are perpetual development only licenses.

For 3-Year (or X-Year) Always Current Packages: Customer will automatically receive all patches, updates and major/minor releases for the duration of the Always Current Package.

The 3-Year Always Current Package is renewable at the same rate, computed at a standard 18% per year maintenance rate.

#### License Transfers:

- a. Research Standard License Configuration - You may transfer a license to a different machine, with the same operating system, up to three (3) times in one (1) year, as long as the license is under the current version. If the license is under an older version, you may pay the upgrade/transfer fee before you may transfer the license. There is a charge to transfer to a different platform (includes upgrade to current version).
- b. Research Always Current Package Configuration - You may transfer a license to a different machine and across supported platforms up to ten (10) times in one (1) year at no additional cost for the active duration of the Always Current Package. For expired subscriptions, standard license configuration rules apply.
